## How to play

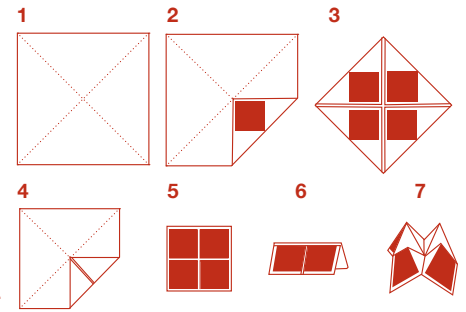

## How to fold

 Cut along the dotted line to separate fortune teller.

- 1 Fold the square along the diagonals to create fold lines. Unfold and place printed side down.
- 2 Fold up all four corners so that the points meet in the middle.
- 3 It should now look like this. Flip it over.
- 4 Fold up all four corners so that the points meet in the middle. Flip it over.
- 5 It should now look like this.
- 6 Now fold the top back.
- 7 Insert your fingers in the flaps.
